

**PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 5 OF GREENE COUNTY**  
**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

**JUNE 8, 2026**

The members of the Board of Directors met at 7:00 pm at the Water Supply office at 113 S. Orchard for the regular monthly meeting of the board. Members present were: Maurice Butler, President; Miles Hartley, Vice President; Colt Johnson, Director; Willie Choate, Director; Jeff Adams, Director. Also, present were Treasurer Mark Bennett, Clerk Heidi Edwards and Water Superintendent Leon Burrell. After declaring a quorum, Butler called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.

The minutes of the last meeting were made available to the board members before the meeting. Hartley made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Johnson seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.

Bennett presented the treasurer's report. Johnson made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Adams seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.

Edwards reported that we have squirrels and birds in the ceiling. She asked if we should get a pest control company to come look. The board asked Burrell if he would look and see where they are coming in.

Burrell asked if we need to have the roofs on our office and wells looked at after the hail storm. The board said we need to call Les Mallard. Edwards stated she would call him tomorrow.

Bennett reported he has called a lot of different companies regarding online bill pay for customers. He is having a hard time finding a company that we don't have to pay the convenience fee. Butler stated to table it.

Online bill pay for customers was tabled.

Bennett reported the new laptop will be delivered tomorrow.

Loss ratio for May was 20%.

Burrell reported we have had two water leaks. One in Northview Circle and one in front of school administration office. Burrell reported that we abandoned a water

line that we shouldn't have. He stated that we need to fix the single line so we don't have to turn people off. The board agreed. There was discussion about if we need to have it engineered. The board doesn't think so since there is already a water line.

Johnson reported he and Burrell have been cycling valves. There are four valves that are stuck.

Burrell reported he would still like to have a dump trailer and skid steer.

Johnson stated they have not had time to do anything with the leak detector. He said the leak that happened today was 92,000 gallons. He was able to see that on the monitor.

Hartley made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Johnson seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.

Hearing no further business, Hartley made a motion to adjourn. Choate seconded. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
