Burrell reported we are pumping over 200,000 a day.

There was discussion about an email Edwards received from a customer. The customer is upset about her water usage. She has a garden she waters. Hartley suggest Edwards send her a copy of her account history. Edwards stated she would.

There was discussion about the duplex project going in across the street from the post office. Icenhower reported there was a meeting at City Hall last week. He said he told them they have to put in an 8-inch water line. The board agreed to let

them put the meters in themselves. We will provide the meters & erts. They will have to provide everything else. Leon will have to be there when they are installing water services.

Short left the meeting at 7:55pm.

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Bennett presented the bills to be paid. Hartley made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Thurman seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.
